



Client Notice Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and is extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

Liberty Women's Clinic ("Clinic"), while adhering to CDC guidelines, cannot guarantee that the premises are COVID-19 free or can the Clinic prevent you or your companions from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while utilizing the Clinic's services or premises. Therefore, if you choose to utilize Clinic's services and/or enter onto Clinic's premises you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

By continuing with services at the Clinic, you are indicating that you have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19 and that you accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 in order to utilize Clinic services and enter the Clinic's premises. These services are of such value to you that you accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize Clinic's services and premises in person rather than an alternative method that may be available.

Social distancing and personal protective equipment such as masks will be utilized pursuant to CDC guidelines.

Please immediately advise the Clinic if any of the following apply to you:

- Experiencing any symptoms of illness such as a fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
- Been exposed in the last 14 days to a person with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.
- Been diagnosed with COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by a qualified medical provider.
